




Location

Cost for transfer by taxi is approx. 60-80 €. The distance from Frankfurt airport to Dorfweil is about 45 km / 50 min by taxi. In case you arrive at airport Frankfurt-Hahn there are 133 km to Dorfweil. Please check transportation possibilities carefully. For further information please contact us in advance.

There are single/double rooms. Comfortable apartments with 2 to 10 beds suitable for up to two families sharing it together. All rooms and apartments have own WC and shower facilities. Apartments usually have a living room and two bathrooms.
